



Dear Oklahoma City Public School Parent or Guardian,

Recent weather conditions required the school district to close schools, because the state law requires students to attend school for 175 days a school year, we have to adjust the school calendar to make up the missed days.

The OKCPS School Board of Education voted to allow district administrators to adjust the calendar by adding additional minutes onto each school day. By adding minutes to each day remaining through the end of the school year, we will not have to extend the school year.

Starting on February 16th all students will attend school an additional 45 minutes every day.

This will make the **last day of school May 21.**

Pre-kindergarten students who attend the afternoon session will start classes later; all other students will start school at the same time as before the inclement weather schedule. The change will affect dismissal time ALL for students.

Below are the start and end times for all OKCPS pre-kindergarten, elementary, middle and high schools:

Grade	Start Time	End Time
Pre-Kindergarten Morning Session	8:30am	11:22am
Pre-Kindergarten Afternoon Session	12:53pm	3:45pm
Elementary Schools	8:30am	3:45pm
Middle Schools	9:20am	4:35pm
High Schools	7:40am	2:55pm

*All combined middle and high schools will continue to start at the same time and end at the new dismissal times noted above.

The above schedule will serve as the board approved calendar unless the school district has to close again for additional weather conditions.
