The Weatherization Assistance Program reduces energy costs for low-income families by increasing the energy efficiency of their homes, while ensuring their health and safety.

Eligibility Requirements

*Any household at or below 200% of federal poverty guideline, is considered low-income. Priority service is given to the elderly, people with disabilities, and families with children.**
