

Growth By the end of the 2019-20 school year, 64% of African American students will be proficient Trajectory: in Reading



Growth By the end of the 2019-20 school year, 56% of African American students will be proficient Trajectory: in Mathematics






### **Accelerated Performance for Under-performing Groups**

Growth By the end of the 2019-20 school year, 53% of ELL scores and 49% IEP student scores will be Trajectory: Satisfactory and Advanced in Reading






# **Accelerated Performance for Under-performing Groups**
