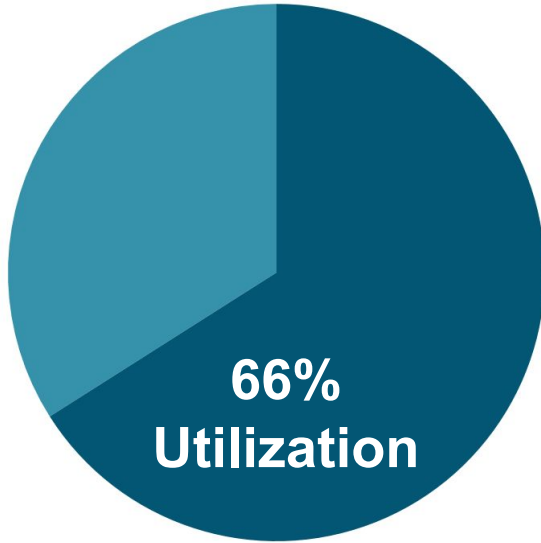

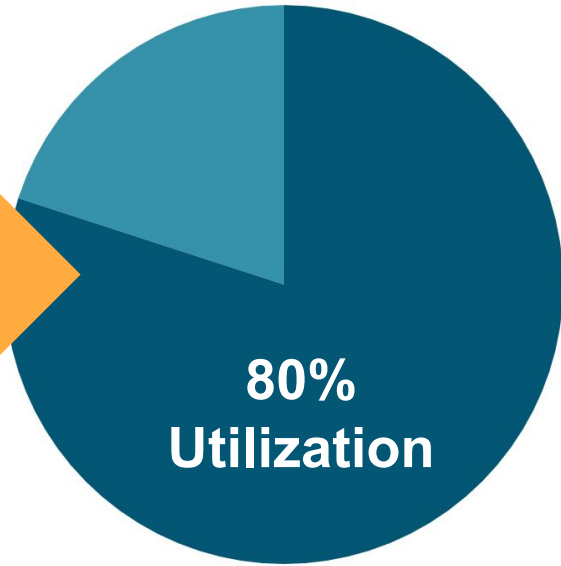

Last year, 40% of elementaries had grades with only 1 teacher

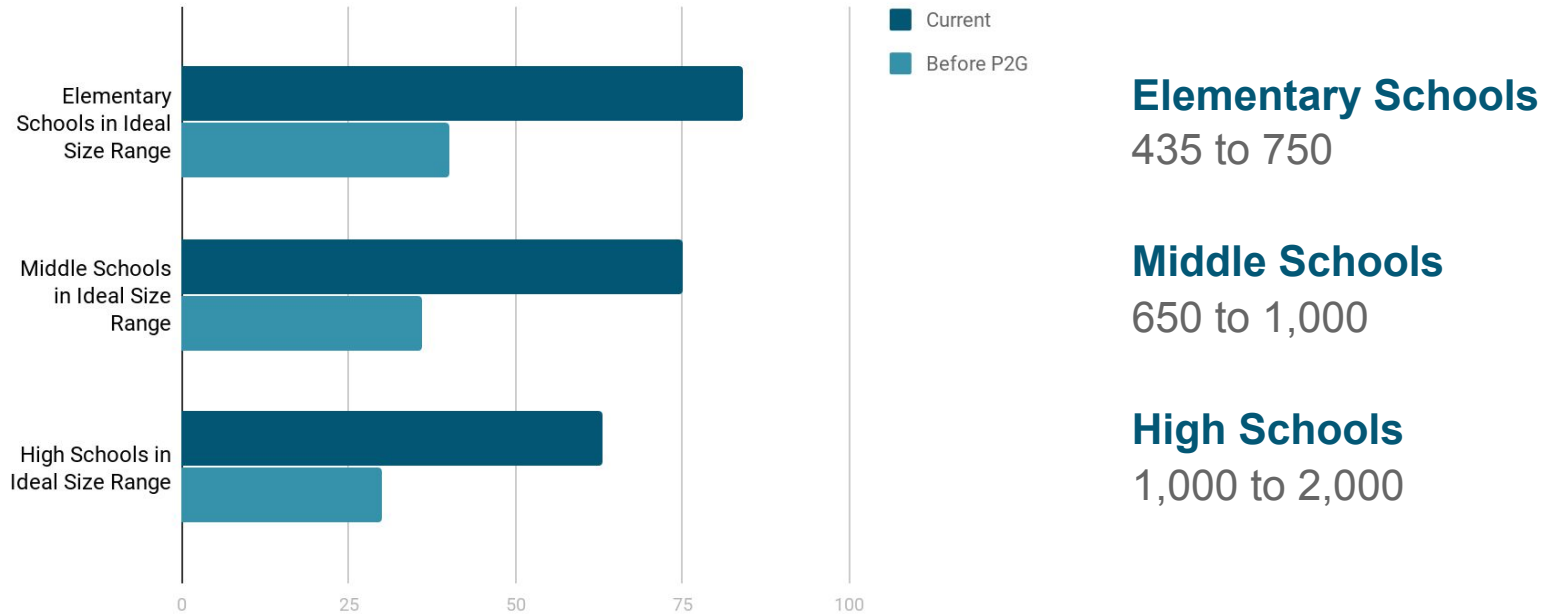


This year, all elementaries have 3-teacher teams at every grade

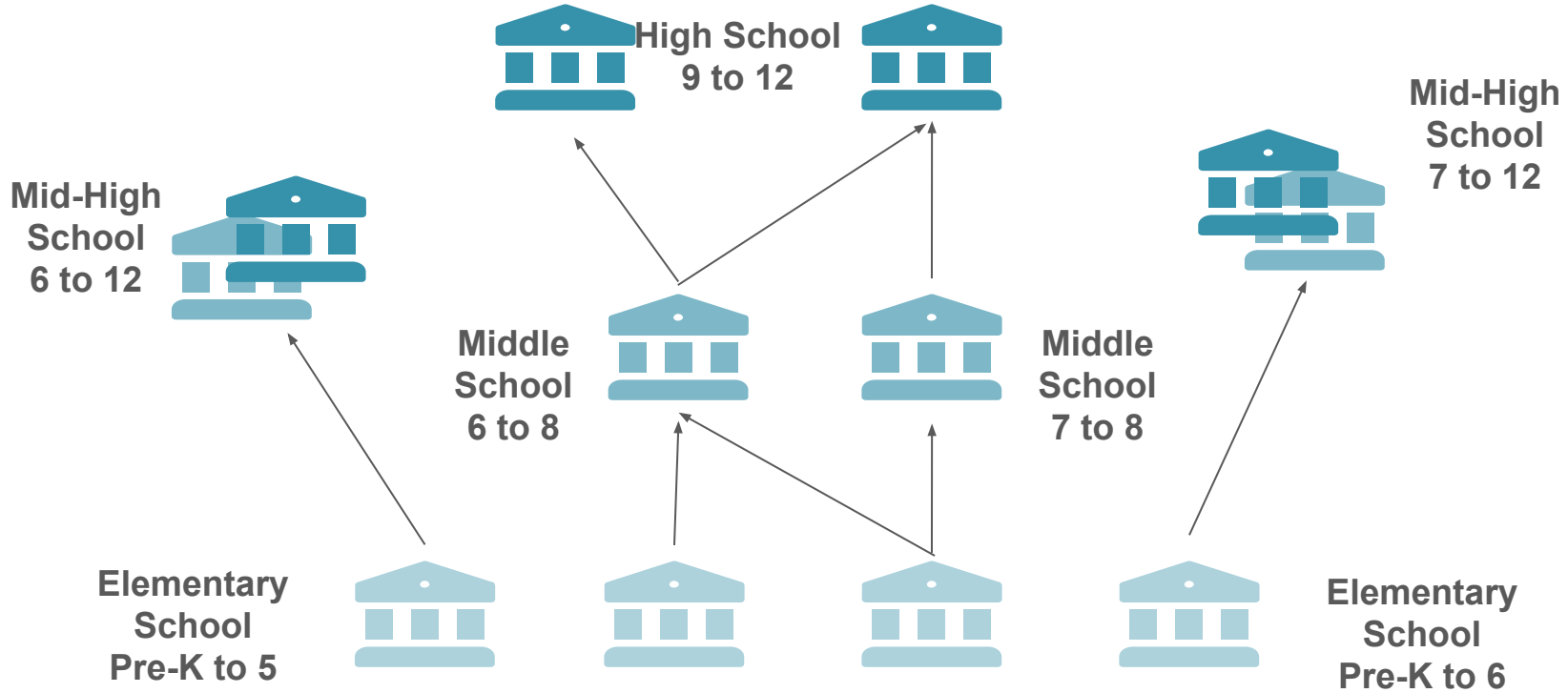


School Size Implications

All HS – full science lab classrooms

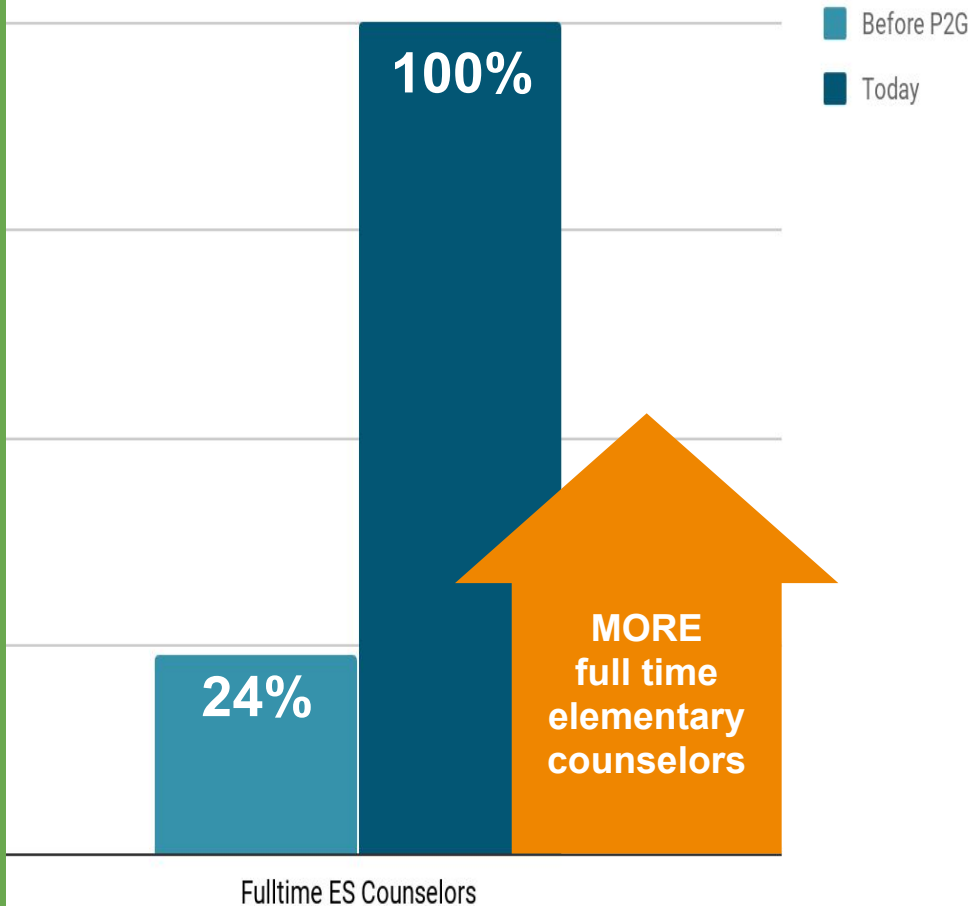
US Grant enrollment dropped by ~400 students

Every 6th grader has access to athletics, fine & performing arts and other co-curriculars (last year only 1 in 5 did)

Successful application school programs increased enrollment by 1,134

Of our 8 new MS fields, 6 are complete and 2 are near completion.

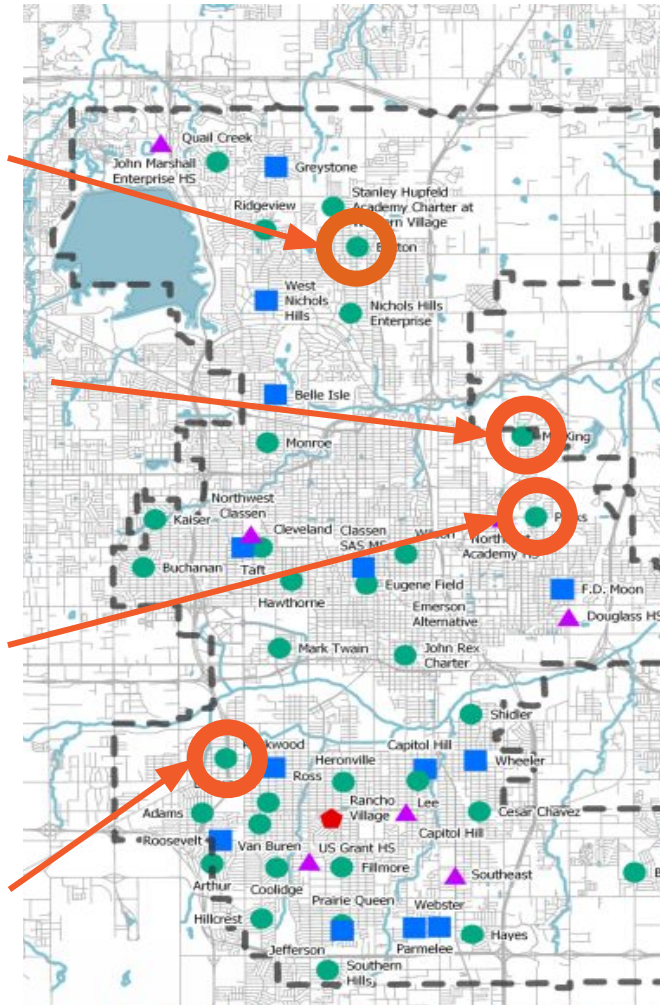

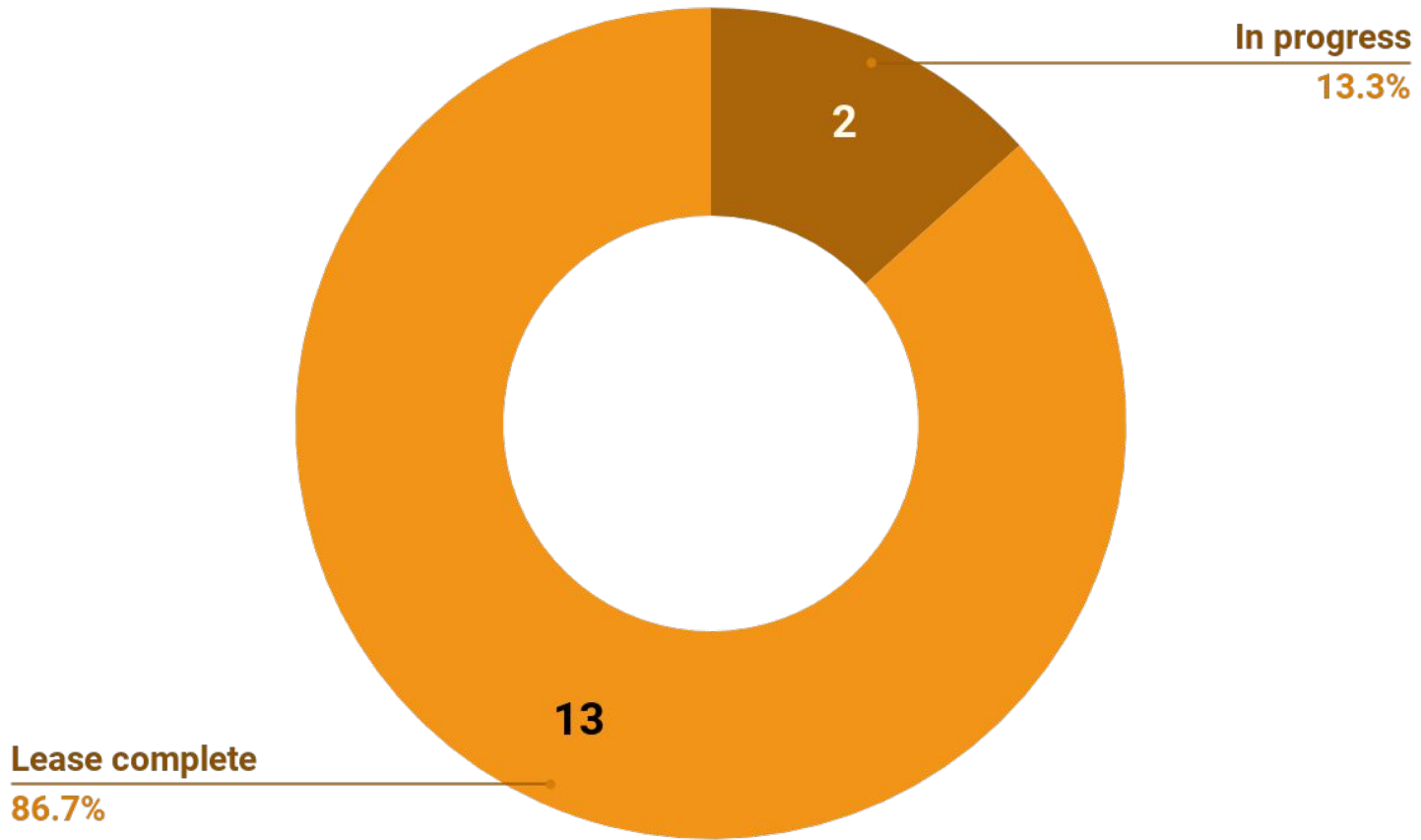
