

2024-25 Parent Engagement Policy

The faculty and staff of Heronville Elementary School believe that parental involvement in the education activities of the school is essential to a student's success or failure in his/her academic endeavors. In keeping with the core belief held by all teachers at Heronville Elementary, the following parental involvement policy has been set forth:

Heronville Elementary shall require every student and parent to discuss and be in verbal agreement with our student/parent/ teacher compact which shall be attached to teacher's canvas home page.

Compacts shall be discussed and teachers shall check to ensure that all students and parents are in agreement with the compact.

At this time, the student/parent/teacher compact shall be discussed as it relates to the individual child's achievement.

Heronville Elementary will conduct parent teacher conferences each semester. The date for the conferences will be determined by the district.

Teachers shall be available to discuss student's progress with the parents. The student compacts shall be discussed as it relates to the child's achievement.

Heronville Elementary shall require all students and parents to sign a computer use statement as well as an internet release form giving or denying permission for a student's picture and/or work to be displayed on the internet when completing pre-registration enrollment documents.

Internet forms, found in the Student/Parent Handbook which are located on the OKCPS website, are available on-line and the completed forms will remain on file in the Infinite Campus enrollment portal.

Heronville will develop a parent involvement policy which is available on the Heronville website and also attached to the teacher's canvas home page.

A parental involvement policy will be made available to parents.

A copy of the parental involvement policy will be available online.

Heronville Elementary faculty will provide frequent reports to parents on their child's progress.

Heronville Elementary teachers shall make contact with students and parents frequently and as needed. Communication will consist of daily attendance and any daily/weekly assignments and assessments.

Heronville Elementary will provide reasonable parental access to staff communication, opportunities to volunteer and participate in their child's class, and schedule observation activities to improve student achievement.

Heronville Elementary teachers will encourage parents to participate in school activities through memos, letters and verbal communication. Examples of activities in which parents are encouraged to participate include:

- Open House
- Rise and Soar
- Grade Level Performance Nights
- Family Literacy Nights
- Class parties

Heronville's Principal will regularly contact parents when students are referred for disciplinary reasons. The principal will call parents to alert them of potential or existing problems with their child. If telephone contact cannot be made, letters will be sent home with the students which must be signed and returned to notify parents of problems.
