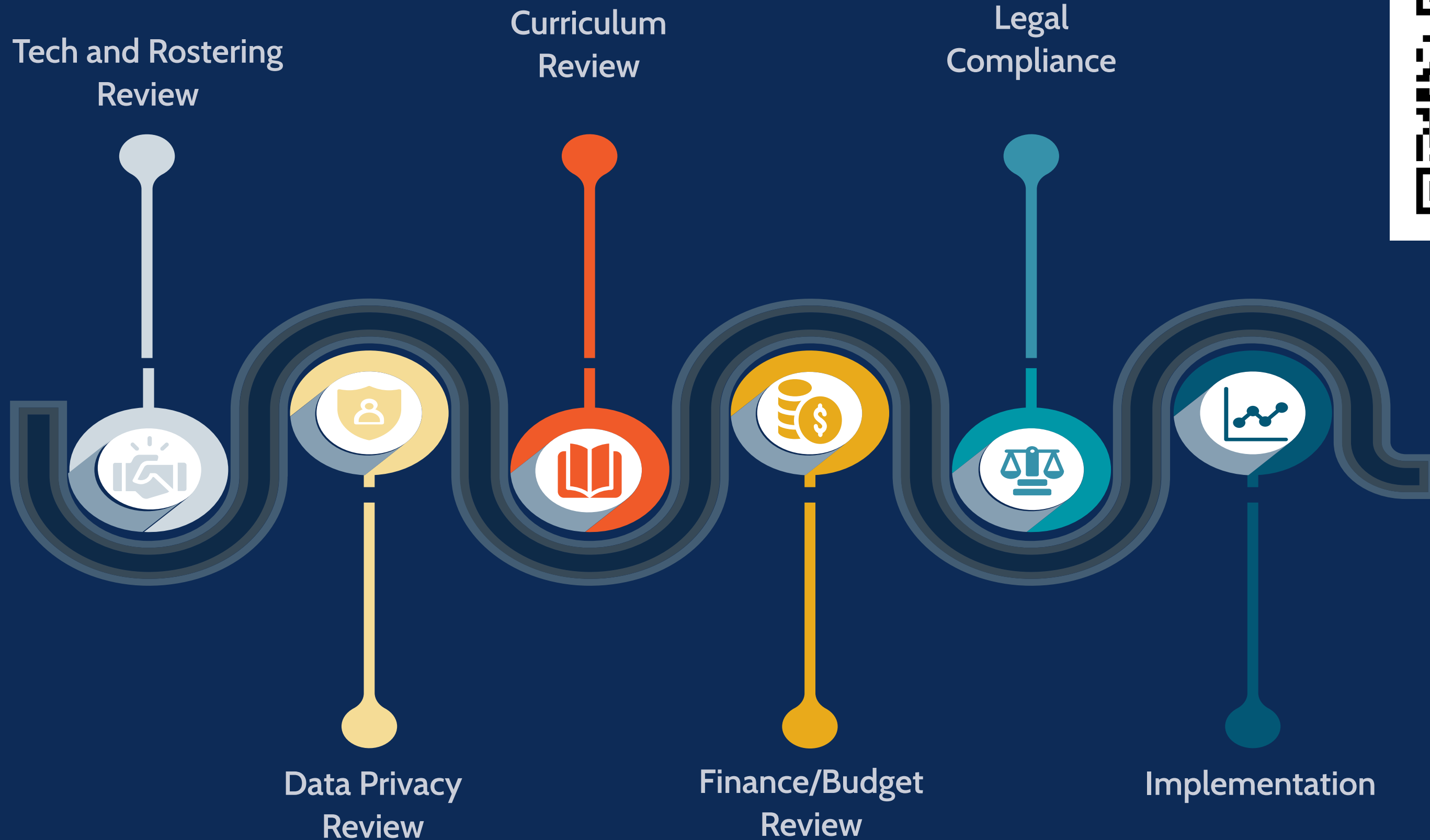

# Why is a Technology Purchase Requisition Form (TPR) necessary?

# To ensure...



## Capacity

---

Confirm the hardware/software technical specifications are compatible with the OKCPS infrastructure.



## Alignment

---

Ensure your software request aligns with Oklahoma Academic Standards, OKCPS Academic initiatives, and will be implemented and sustained for its intended purpose.



## Legal

---

Verify the adherence to all state/federal laws and regulations, OKCPS board policies, and established data privacy best practices.





# When is a Technology Purchase Requisition Form (TPR) necessary?

When to do a TPR


- When requesting to purchase desktop & laptop computers, touchscreen tablets, printers, projectors, interactive flat panels, and digital content (software).

When to do a TPR

- When requesting to purchase desktop & laptop computers, touchscreen tablets, printers, projectors, interactive flat panels, and digital content (software).
- A TPR is NOT required for accessories (keyboard, mice, document cameras, power adapters, headphones, etc.).

If you are not sure, simply reach out to the Director of Client Services.





**Why does all software have  
to go through an approval  
process?**

Security

When using an online service provider for instructional purposes, schools must accept responsibility for transferring a large amount of student information to the provider.

OKCPS must review all online providers to ensure that proper privacy protections are met.

Security

If student privacy requirements are not met, the online service could cause the school/district to be out of compliance with federal regulations and privacy standards.

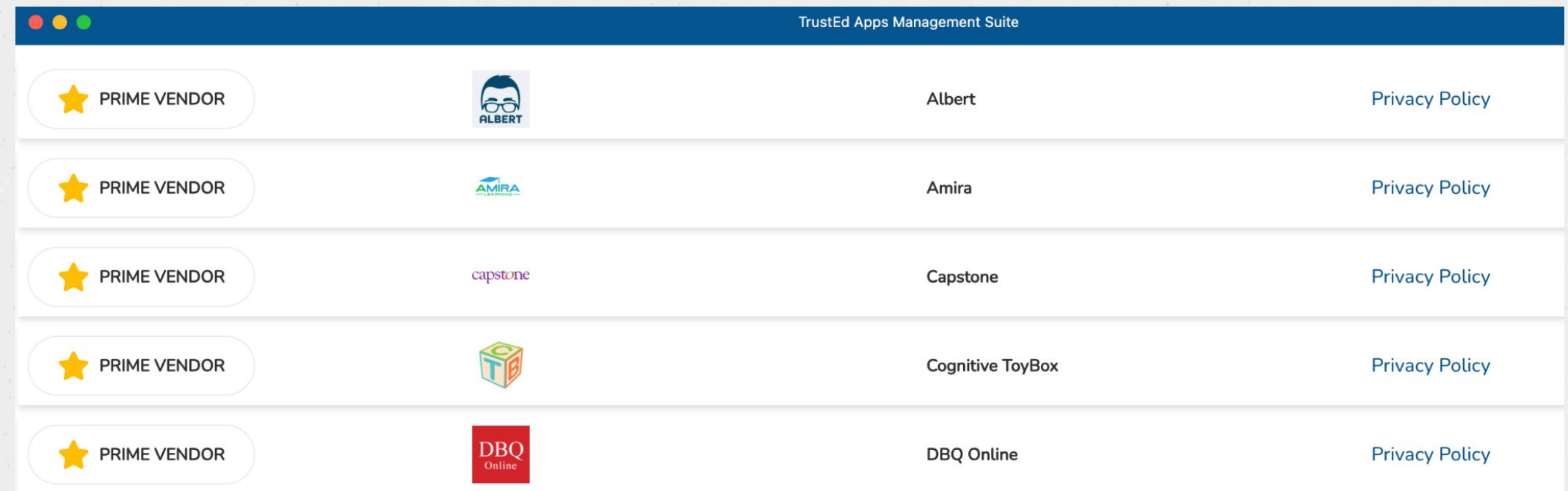

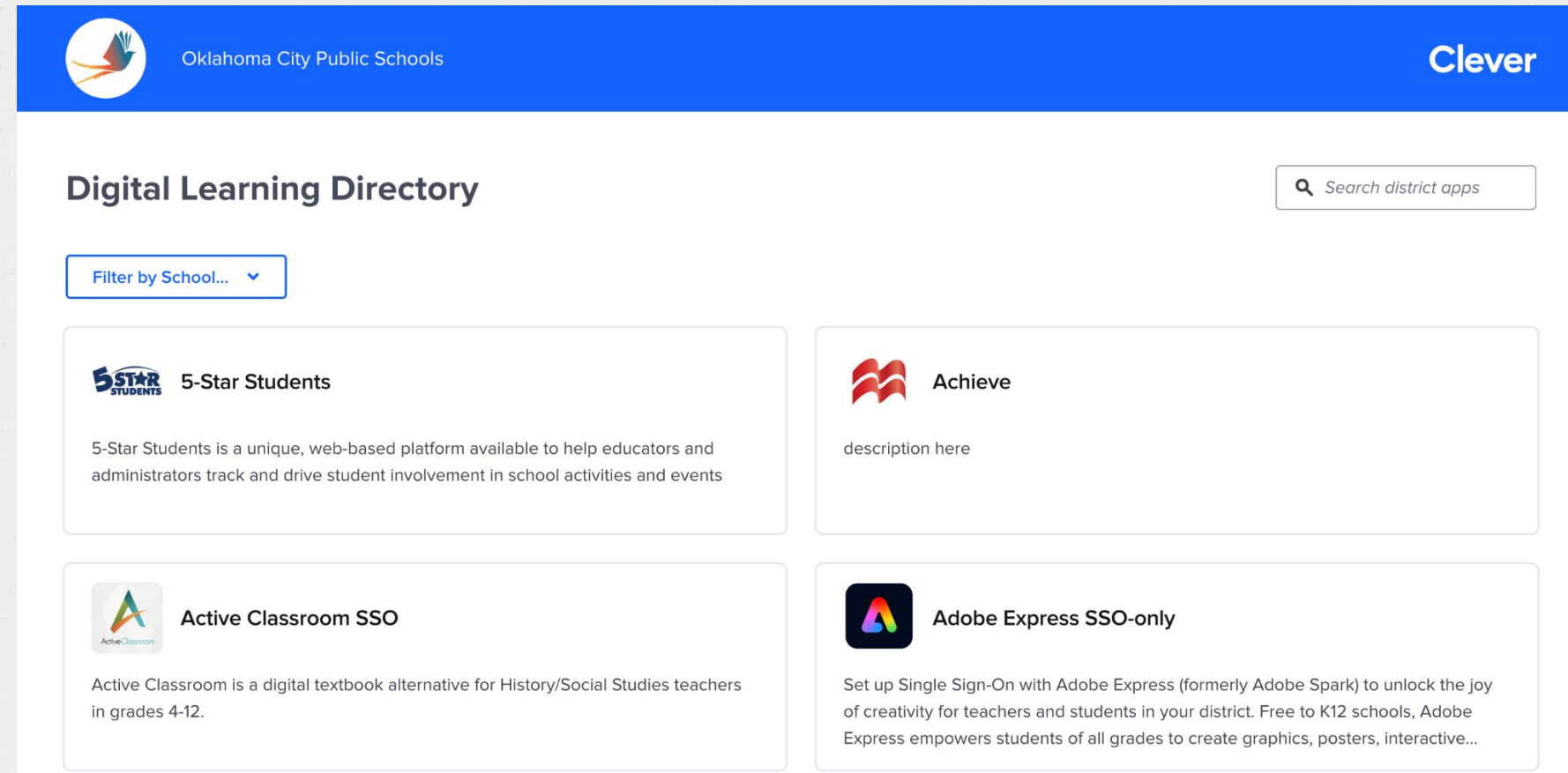

  - Example: If you are submitting your request on July 29th, the quote expiration date should be on or after **August 29th**.
- **Start Dates:** Subscription start dates cannot be prior to the date of the purchase order.
  - **Recommendation:** Start date should state: Upon Purchase Order Receipt
- **End Dates:** All subscriptions must end on **June 30th**.

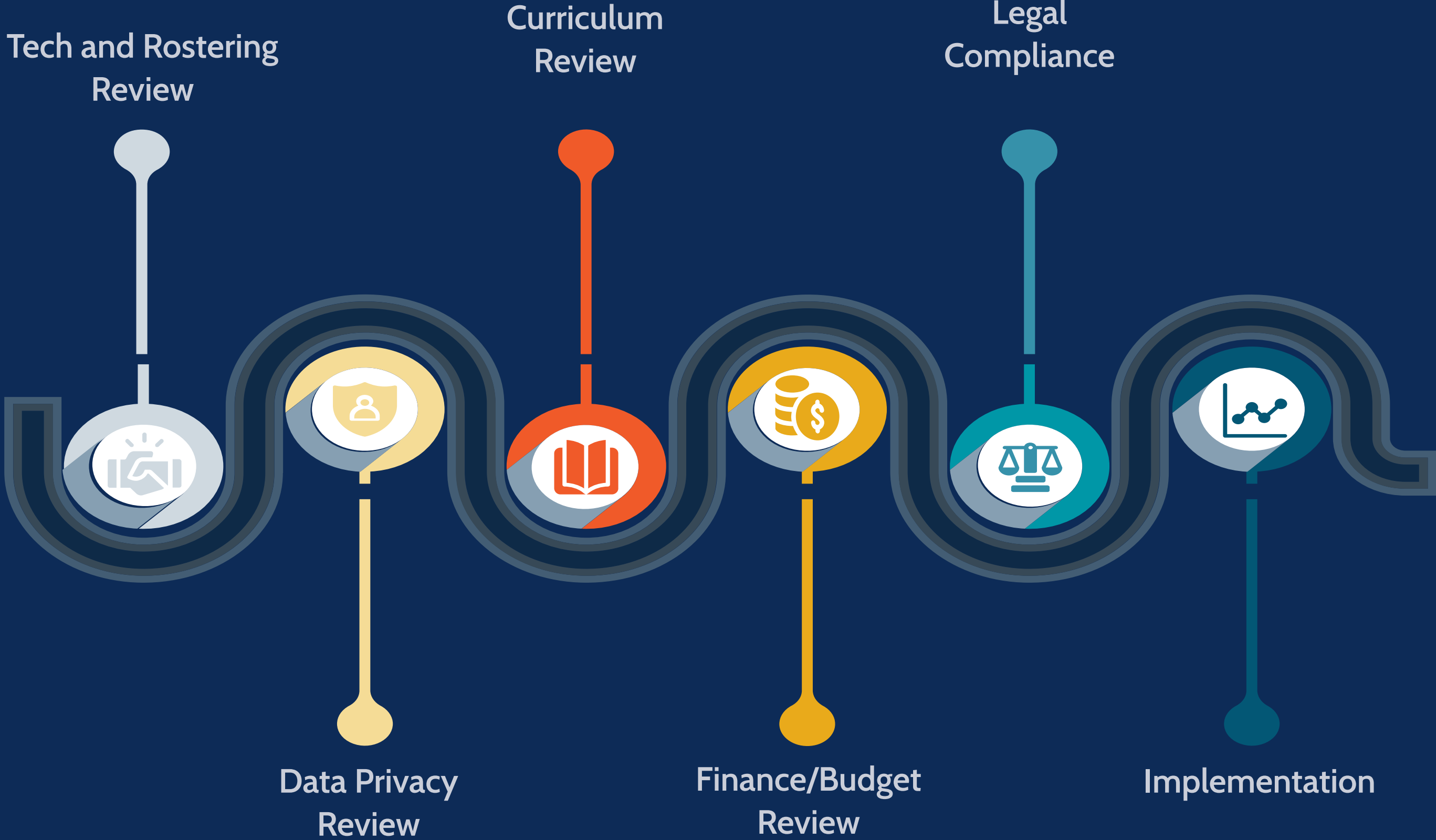
