4. Updates on Data Gathering
  - i. Impact on Students – Amount of instructional time before testing is minimal. Should we survey students? Should we survey parents?
  - ii. Impact on Employees – All staff that reports after 7/15 would be required to miss one paycheck if the district goes back to the traditional calendar. AFT has surveyed their members with 72% in favor of retaining the CLC. Should we survey the entire workforce? If so, should we separate support, professional technical, instructional?
  - iii. Utility Costs -- pending
  - iv. Transportation Issues – Only 30 of the district’s fleet of buses are air conditioned due to the additional cost of A/C at approximately \$30,000/bus
  - v. Maintenance Issues – Available time to do deep cleaning in the schools is limited in the summers due to the shortened summer break
  - vi. Community input –Need to determine how to gather input from the community.
  - vii. SNS – Significant negative funding impact due to the earlier start time of the CLC.
  - viii. Early Childhood – No significant impact.
  - ix. Athletics – The CLC poses issues with the 2 week fall break and spring break when other schools are in session and practices and games are ongoing.
