 Consideration of AT MUST be documented on ALL IEPs in the Objective Statement on the "Strengths/Needs, Special Factors, Parent Concerns" page

EVEN IF AT IS NOT REQUIRED

Example: "Assistive technology was considered and is not required at this time." This is also the place to document if the team is unsure if AT is needed. Use this space to note anything being considered for trial use. List what the student needs the device to do, NOT the name of the device being considered.
