<u>Stanley's Graduation Services</u>- Wednesday, September 3rd- Stanley Graduation services will be at both lunches to take payments or partial payments on graduation supplies. Payments for cap and gown <u>should not</u> be made to Stanley's, those go to Mrs. Campbell.
