Uniform Policy

Uniforms are a REQUIREMENT for all students.



Tops: White, Gray, or Navy Bottoms: Khaki or Navy

Leggings may only be worn under uniform, not as pants.

Jackets/Sweaters/Sweatshirts

All clothing worn inside must adhere to school colors (above).

Jackets for outside do not have to adhere.

Shoes

Closed toe shoes are required at all times on school property.

SpiritWear

Spirit Wear shirts may be worn as a uniform any day! This includes Spirit Wear from previous years and Crusader Day shirts.

Student Pick-Up and Drop-Off

Our desire is for parent pick-up and drop-off to be as safe as possible for our students.

Please note the following information:

MORNING DROP-OFF PROCEDURES

➤ Doors open and supervision begins at 7:45 in the morning. For the safety of your child, please have them remain in your vehicle until 7:45 am. All students will go directly to the cafeteria for breakfast.

> First Bell: 8:10

Tardy Bell: 8:20

LATE DROP-OFF (AFTER 8:20)

> Please walk your student into the office to sign them in and receive a tardy slip. All late arrivals are recorded on the student's attendance.

VISITORS AND EARLIER PICK-UP

- Every adult who is picking up a child before the dismissal bell must display a current driver's license or government picture ID.
- ➤ Early checkout ends at 2:30! There will be **no checkouts after 2:30**, unless there is an emergency. This is to ensure a safe dismissal for every student.

DISMISSAL

Every adult picking up a child at dismissal is required to have the School Safe ID tag. Without a car tag, you will be asked to park in a parking spot and provide your driver's license for verification. Staff will verify with the office that you are allowed to pick up that student.


*PLACE SCHOOL SAFE ID TAG IN A VISIBLE SPOT IN YOUR WINDSHIELD

- First 2 car tags are free. Cost to replace is \$5. Please see the office for additional tags.
- All students will be dismissed from their classrooms to their designated dismissal door.

Student Pick-up and Drop-Off

- **Kindergarten, 1st Grade, and their older siblings** will be dismissed from Thorn Ridge Rd (Circle drive, west side of school building)
- 2nd-4th Grade will be dismissed from Rosewood Ln (Main parking lot, south side of building)
- Bus Loading
 - DO NOT PASS when buses are present! It is against the law and for safety of the children. Bus loading is in front of the stairs on Thorn Ridge Road.
- **Daycare Pick-Up** will be in front of the loading dock. Staff will bring them to your vehicle. Please have daycare signage on the vehicle!
- Parent Walk-up (all grades) is located on the dock area. Please park on Thorn Ridge Rd facing south and have your School Safe ID tag with you.



Please help keep all of our Quail Creek students and staff safe during dismissal. We will do our best to make the traffic go as smoothly and quickly as possible. BE KIND. BE SAFE. BE RESPECTFUL.






