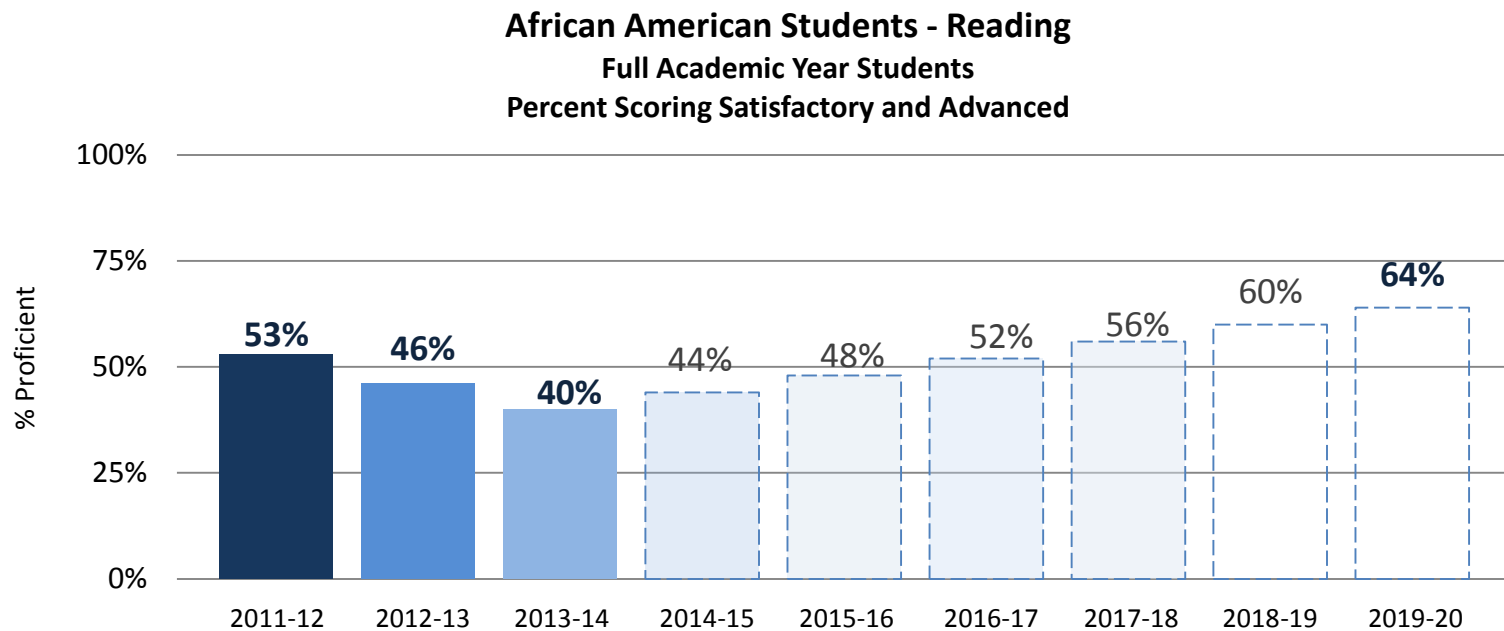




## Accelerated Performance for Under-performing Groups

Reading scores for all regular education Full Academic Year students grade 3-8.

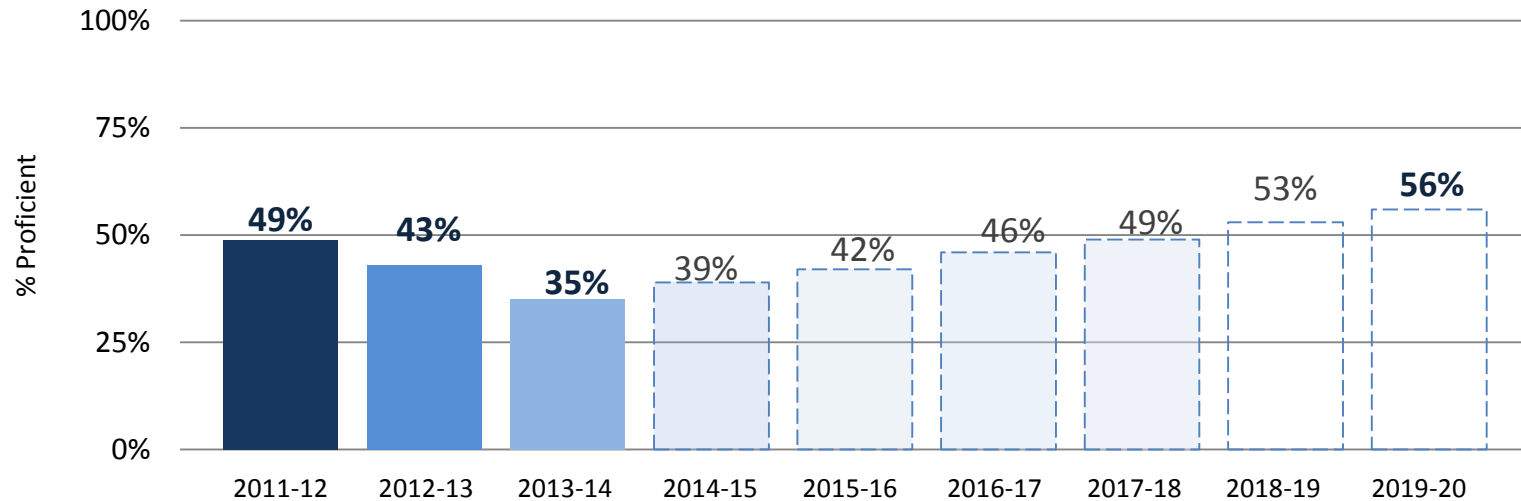
**Growth Trajectory:** By the end of the 2019-20 school year, 64% of African American students will be proficient in Reading

Mathematics scores for all regular education Full Academic Year students grade 3-8.

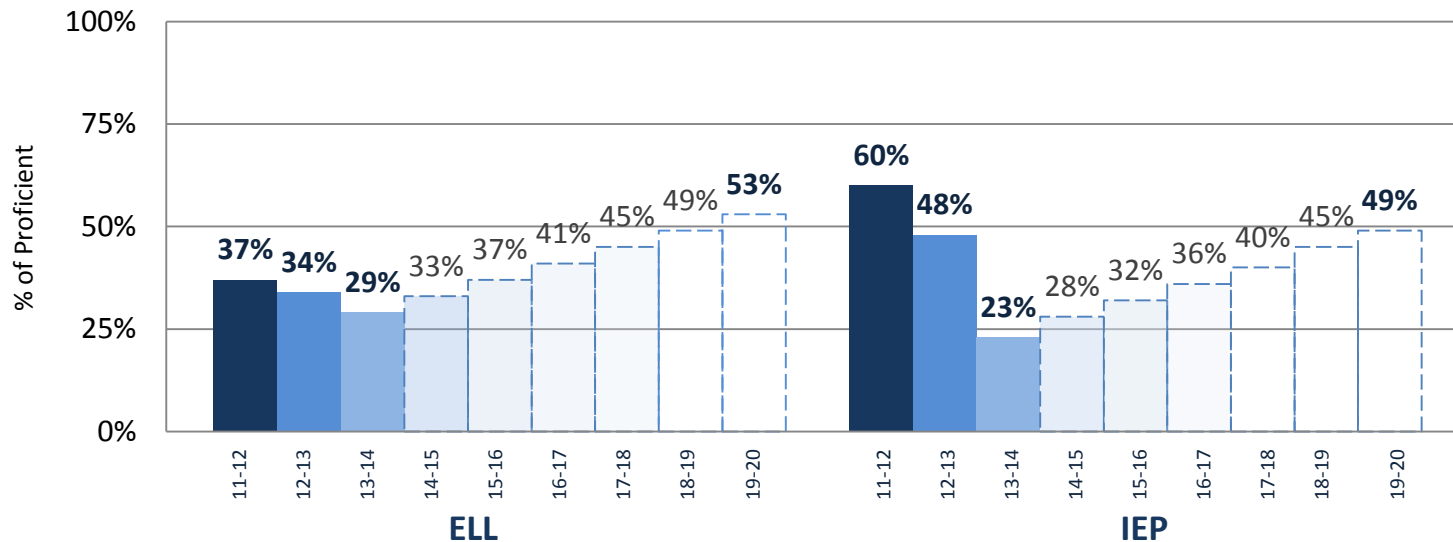
**Growth Trajectory:** By the end of the 2019-20 school year, 56% of African American students will be proficient in Mathematics

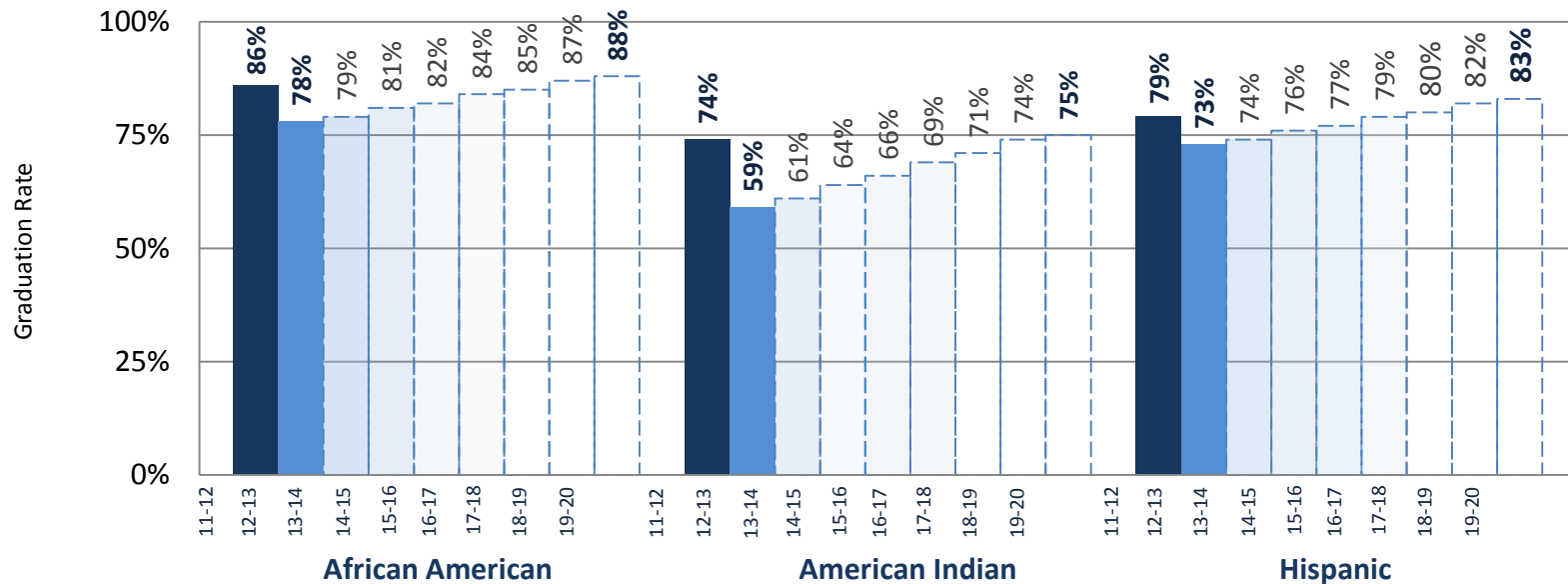

## Accelerated Performance for Under-performing Groups

**End Goal:** By the end of the 2029-30 school year, 100% of African American, American Indian, and Hispanic students will graduate high school

**Growth Trajectory:** By the end of the 2019-20 school year, 88% of African American students, 75% of American Indian students, and 83% of Hispanic students will graduate high school
