Whereas, Mrs. Anna King is a graduate of Oklahoma City Public Schools, having attended Quail Creek Elementary, North Highland 5th Year Center, F.D. Moon Middle School, Capitol Hill High School, and Emerson Alternative High School; and,

Whereas, while an OKCPS student, Anna participated in basketball, track, cross country, and Vocational Industrial Clubs of America (VICA) and was honored as the Quail Creek Student of the Month, F.D. Moon Basketball Player of the Year, and Capitol Hill High School Athlete of the Year; and,

Whereas, since 2005, Anna has served as a board member of the Douglass Law and Public Safety Academy, secretary and president of the Douglass High School Parent Teacher Student Association, president of the Oklahoma City Parent Teacher Association (PTA) Council, and president of the Oklahoma State PTA; and,

Whereas, after serving in numerous executive level positions—and president-elect since 2019—in 2021, Anna was elected president of the National Parent Teacher Association, the largest child advocacy organization in the country; and,
